In memoriam: the Great War

Charles Henry Douglas COOK Aged 29, 9 March 1918

Born in Plymouth, son of Charles and Philadelphia Cook, who moved to Portloe in the coastguard service, he served as petty officer on war vessels as Yeoman of Signals. He died of pulmonary tuberculosis and gastro-enteritis while still on active service.

Private Reginald John James BUCKINGHAM Aged 27, 23 March 1918

Born Wynberg, South Africa, eldest son of James and Susan Buckingham of Ruan Lanihorne, he served in the Duke of Cornwall's Light Infantry and the 6th Battalion Somerset Light Infantry. He died of wounds received at the Battle of St. Quentin where his battalion was attached to the 43rd Brigade, 14th (Light) Division
