## Veryan churchyard gates - Sentry Lane access An appeal for help



These gates were presented in 1954 in memory of Mrs Maud Guy Hearle Evans.
They are now difficult to open and close and access to the churchyard is increasingly difficult.
The gates are also in a poor state of repair and the Parochial Church Council has agreed that they should be replaced.

Please will you help?

An estimate has been received for the making and installing of new gates similar in design to the existing ones, made in galvanised steel and powder-coated black.

The price will be around £2600 including VAT.
