6th October - we remember William Tyndale, martyr

Tyndale was burnt at the stake on 6th October 1536 as a punishment for translating the New Testament and much of the Old Testament into English. His work was nevertheless completed by Miles Coverdale and their joint translation formed the basis for the 'King James' version of the Bible published in 1611. The lessons at Veryan's Harvest Evensong on 6 October will be read from Tyndale's translation.

VERYAN & DISTRICT OPEN AUTUMN SHOW

At one of our Show planning meetings our excellent secretary Margaret produced the cover of a catalogue of Veryan's show dated 1932, describing it as the 'third annual show'. A Cottage Garden Society and Show had been introduced in the 1890s by Canon Kempe, after the introduction by the newly-created Parish Council of parish allotments (known locally as 'Australia' and 'New Zealand'). This show had lapsed during the Great War but after the completion of the Hall in 1926 a new committee was created and the Show in its present form was established.

To mark its 90th year 'long-service' certificates were awarded to two members of the committee each of whom had served continuously for 33 years, Cyril Channon as vice-chairman and chairman, and Margaret Cortis as secretary (she hasn't given up - she's now chairman, with Ros Hocking as secretary...)

Huge thanks to everyone involved in a wonderfully successful day - Rev'd Philip for opening the event, the school for its wonderful musical performance, and for the many entries (but we need more next from you year!), all the willing entrants who baked, grew, arranged, created and otherwise made so many things to exhibit, the judges, the WI for delicious teas and above all the committee and helpers behind the scenes - it wouldn't happen without you!
